Statement on Racism

The reality is that people of color in the United States are living every day with what all of us watched in the George Floyd video. We pledge to raise our voice in opposition to acts of racial discrimination and to fight tirelessly against the sin of racism.

We stand with the U.S. bishops' pastoral, Open Wide Our Hearts, in calling for a "genuine conversion of heart, a conversion that will compel change, and the reform of our institutions and society."
